Who is eligible for a scholarship?

- (a) Students must be an AANR member or have a parent, grandparent or guardian that is an AANR member.
- (b) Students must plan to attend a college/university or a technical/trade school as a full-time student.
- (c) Winners of AANR regional scholarships will be considered for additional funds.

What are the applicant's responsibilities?

- a) Complete an application form.
- b) Complete the essay questions.
- c) Obtain two (2) letters of recommendation (see below).
- d) Send us your latest transcript. So, get us a transcript of your secondary education if you are enrolling for your first year at a college/technical/vocational school or a transcript of your current post-secondary school if you have already left high school. If you are not currently enrolled, please ask that the transcript from the last school that you attended be sent to us.

All of the above items must be dated on or before May 1 of the application year. These items must be sent to scholarships@aanr-ef.com.

What letters of recommendation are needed?

- (a) A letter of academic recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, or administrator.
- (b) A letter of personal recommendation from a person of authority in the applicant's local community (employer, volunteer organization, etc.).

What is the review process?

The AANR-EF Scholarship Committee will review all completed applications by June 15 for the current calendar year using only the information provided by the applicant. All applicants will be notified by July 1 of the committee's decision.
