

William Bisbee Scholarship Award Application

This is a one-time scholarship funded by William Bisbee, a Montana resident who has been involved with social nudism at resorts throughout the United States for over 40 years, notably establishing a Montana travel club which thrived for 25 years.

Requirements:

- A student without prior nudist experience will attend a nudist club for 2-3 days;
- The student will be responsible for all club fees, overnights, meals, and will adhere to the respectful behavior policies of the club and of AANR. (Note: For all applications received by May 1, 2023, the AANR Education Foundation will coordinate with the club in an effort to secure discounted fees for the student, if possible.)
- Following the visit, the student will write an article or paper about the experience;
- The student will submit the article or paper electronically to the AANR Education Foundation (board@aanr-ef.com) for review and judging;
- The student writing the article or paper judged by the Foundation to be the best will be announced at the AANR annual convention, and the monies will be paid to the institution of higher learning;
- The student must grant to the AANR Education Foundation rights to publish the article/paper in the AANR Bulletin, the Undressed Press, the Naturist Hub, and the visited club's newsletter, plus any other publication selected by AANR.
- The applicant shall retain all rights for publication in other media provided recognition of the AANR Education Foundation, AANR, and the club visited are included in said publication(s), including any college newspaper;
- The judging panel will retain the right to withhold the award in the event that no article or paper meets the standards of the judges, or if there are insufficient number of submissions to make a fair and acceptable evaluation;
- If the student secures publication of the article or paper in a national or regional non-nudist publication, i.e., newspaper or magazine, and submits proof of publication to the judges prior to the final award date, an additional \$1,000 will be added to the award.
- If the article or paper includes photos, every individual in the photo(s) must sign the photo release included with this application, and the signed photo release must be submitted with the article. The release can be submitted electronically.

Timeline:

- Due date for applications to be eligible for assistance with coordination with clubs: May 1, 2023;
- AANR-EF assistance with club coordination: March 1-July 16, 2023;
- Final due date for all applications: July 16, 2023;
- Club visit must take place between March 15 and July 16, 2023
- Due date for submission of article or paper: July 25, 2023;
- Evaluation period: July 25-August 8, 2023;
- Announcement of winner at the AANR Annual convention August 7-14 at Solair Recreation League, Woodstock, Connecticut.

Eligibility – Applicant must:

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Be fully enrolled at an accredited college or university;
- Be in the second year of college or later;
- Have a stated educational goal;
- Not be a member of AANR or The Naturist Society, the International Nudist Federation, or of the club visited. This is to be a first-time experience.

In order to facilitate coordination of the club designated for the first visit, submit this application before beginning the process.
